

HEALTH TIP

Recipe: The Greens Power Smoothie

Nutrient-dense and full of tasty goodness, this greens power-packed smoothie would even impress Popeye.

Greens Power Smoothie

- 10 oz. coconut milk

- 1 tablespoon Spirulina
- 2 teaspoons date paste*

Place coconut milk in a high-speed blender and add all other ingredients. Blend until smooth.

*Chef's tip: You can make fresh date paste by taking one cup of soaked, pitted dates and blending them until smooth. Place in a glass mason jar and store in the refrigerator.
